Re: Grant Funding for Teacher Classroom Materials & Professional Development

The Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce a grant opportunity for all teachers at FRCS. In total \$2,000 will be awarded for classroom materials and/or fees associated with instruction and assessment focused on improving and enhancing the classroom environment. A maximum of \$1,000 for upper school and \$1,000 for lower school will be awarded. The grant recipients will be selected by a subcommittee of the Scholarship Committee. Announcement of the grants will be made after the FRCS Silent Auction March 15, 2008.

Upon receipt of the grant and completion of the program, the grant recipient will be required to share information acquired and provide practical applications for the classroom/the entire school. The core requirements of this program are as follows: (1) staff needs to be able to demonstrate how their proposal will improve or enhance the classroom environment and (2) provide practical applications for the classroom or entire school

Last year funds were awarded to Linda Noiseaux to purchase *Fizz & Martina's Math Adventures* software to supplement the 2nd grade math curriculum; and Carrie Ruggiero to purchase some classroom furniture to create an effective and efficient learning environment in the inclusion setting. Other examples can include paying for course fees or purchase materials. All proposed fees and materials costs are subject to the approval of the scholarship committee.

To be considered, please submit an electronically completed application proposal by the application **deadline, February 28, 2008**. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.
