Course Descriptions

American Girl Doll Week**Shelley Howland**
Bring your American Girl or other doll to a fun-filled week of making doll accessories, clothing and trying new hair styles. We will end the week with a dress-up tea party.
(This course will be offered to students entering grades 1, 2 and 3)

Animal Adventures**Linda Noiseux**
Calling all animal lovers! The children will learn about different animals and their habitats from around the world. They will take part in hands-on craft making, creative games, and other activities.
(This course will be offered for students entering grades 1-3)

AP Chemistry Prep Course.....**Peter Gaudet**
AP Chemistry requires an intense summer assignment covering four chapters of work from a college level chemistry text book, with numerous problems. In the first week of the course, prospective AP Chemistry students would be guided through the more difficult problems. The second week will focus on doing 5 of the 20 labs required in the AP course.
(This course will be offered to prospective AP Chemistry students entering gr. 10 & 11)

Artistic Bonanza.....**Cheryl Lassey**
Students will create a variety of unique artistic creations using everyday materials. Projects will range from a portrait collage, "stained" glass vase, decorative picture frame and more! Students will experiment with their imaginations.
An additional materials fee of \$5.00 is added for this course
(This course will be offered to students entering grades 4-6)

Become an Author and an Illustrator.....Alison Daley

Children will become authors of their own books. They will have an opportunity to tell about their summer, what they expect their next school year to be like and use their imagination. They will add pictures to their “published” books.

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 1-3)

Board Games Galore.....Cheryl Lassey

Create your own board game to take home!! You will design a board game relating to your favorite subject or create your own version of one of your favorite games. We will use the computer to design your board and we will create game pieces too! Think about the rules, you will print them and then we will turn our hard work into “game time”.

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 4-6)

Brushes, Paper and Pencils.....Karen Prizio

Students will learn about famous artist and experiment with different medias. We will be using colored pencils, paints, water colors and much more. Creativity is a must!

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 2-4)

Candle Making.....Cheryl Lassey

Students will learn the craft of candle making. Students will each create a different candle creation daily using a variety of techniques and materials. **An additional materials fee of \$5.00 is added for this course**

(This course will be offered to students in grades 3-5)

Eco-Fun.....Erin O’Callahan

Students will explore the environment and the wonders of ecology through fun games, songs and activities. Students will learn about animals, plants, and non-living things and how they affect the environment.

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 2-5)

Fun with Digital CamerasRyan Pinsoneault

Students will become familiarized with digital camera use and a variety of digital media. They will learn how to make colorful and fun presentations such as slideshows, pamphlets, and newsletters which they will be sure to enjoy sharing with family and friends. **Students must bring their own digital camera, its battery charger or extra batteries.**

(This course will be offered for students entering grades 4-6)

Fun with French.....Merites Abelard

Learn to speak French! The children will have the opportunity to explore French, Canadian, and Haitian cultures through basic communicative skills in French.

(This course will be offered for students entering grades 5 and 6)

Fun with Math.....Rachna Kouli

Students will learn math concepts using games and fun activities.

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 3-4)

Games! Games! Games 1.....Ryan Pinsoneault

Students will have a chance to play several fun and exciting games. Some educational and some just for fun!

(This course will be offered for students entering grades 1-3)

Games! Games! Games 2.....Ryan Pinsoneault

Students will have a chance to play several educational and strategy games like Scrabble, Boggle, Chess, Zeus of the Loose, and plenty of others!

(This course will be offered for students entering grades 4-6)

Going Back in Time.....Shelley Howland

Learn what it was like living in Colonial times. We'll have fun seeing what it was involved in making clothes and making a meal. We'll also explore games the children played as well as what it was like on laundry day.

(This course will be offered for students entering grades 2, 3 and 4)

Jump Start Kindergarten:..... Cynthia DeTore

This course is designed for children entering kindergarten as of September, 2009.

Children will be given an opportunity to become more familiar with the kindergarten classroom and participate in activities, which will follow a typical kindergarten routine.

The schedule will be as follows: Circle Time, Snack, Activity/Center Time, Recess, Story Time, and Dismissal.

Junior Architects..... Cheryl Lassey

Students will explore how buildings are designed and built. They will learn about different types of buildings, materials and structures. Students will design their own building. (This course will be offered to students entering grades 4-6)

Kids in the Kitchen 1.....Cheryl Lassey

Calling young chefs!! We will stir up your child's interest in the kitchen by making fun treats that will tickle the taste buds. Students will learn cooking skills by doing and having fun. Each student will create a cookbook of the recipes and take home samples to share. **If your child has any food related allergies they MUST be stated on the registration form.**

Kids in the Kitchen 2.....Cheryl Lassey

This course is an extension of the "Kids in the Kitchen 1" course. We will be creating many different and exciting recipes. Students will bring home samples of these yummy treats to share as well as their personal cookbook. **If your child has any food related allergies they MUST be stated on the registration form.**

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 2-4)

Legoville..... Ryan Pinsoneault

Students will work together to create a Lego city, skyscraper, space station, or whatever they can imagine! Students will use some of their mathematical skills to estimate how many Lego's they will use and graph all the colors!

(This course will be offered for students entering grades 1-3)

Mad Scientist.....Linda Noiseux

Get messy, get loud, get shocked! Students will take part in hands-n science experiments. We will be participating in some wonderful experiments from the PBS television show "Zoom".

(This course will be offered to students entering grades 1-3)

Play to Learn.....Alison Daley

Students will use Wheel of Fortune to spell sight words, months, days, etc. We will learn crossword puzzles to solve math sentences, spell number words, etc. Students will put together puzzles we create in class.

(This course will be offered to students entering grade 1-2)

Recycled Percussion.....Erin O'Callahan

Students will find new, fun and LOUD ways to use recyclable materials. We will learn about Stomp, the musical, rhythm and the science of sound. The course will end in a concert show on Thursday.

(This course will be offered to students entering grades2-4)

Soccer Camp, (1-3).....**Ryan Pinsoneault**
Students will learn the rules and skills of soccer at a beginner’s level. Students will play a variety of exciting new games to develop their soccer abilities while enjoying a non-competitive atmosphere. We may even have our own mini-tournament at the end of the week. (This course will be offered to students entering grades 1-3)

Soccer Camp, 4-6..... **Ryan Pinsoneault**
Students of all ability levels will experience fun soccer games to help develop their skills on the field. Students will learn new strategies for playing every position. We will end each day with a scrimmage among all players to replicate what a game day feels like. (This course will be offered to students entering grades 4-6)

Students will create many craft pieces: bracelets, necklaces, totebags and more.
An additional materials fee of \$5.00 is added for this course

Enjoy the sun and outdoors while learning and playing some creative and classic outdoor games. You will spend time playing wiffle ball, kickball, frisbee baseball, touch football, soccer, relay races and much more!
