Students who reside outside our district communities may also apply for admission. Please note that all out-of-district applicants will remain after any in-district applicants on the grade appropriate waitlist. Foxborough Regional Charter School does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, ethnicity, disability, gender, or sexual orientation in its educational programs or activities or in its employment practices and procedures.

Please note that children entering first grade must be 6 years of age by August 31st. Kindergarten applications for the 2010-2011 school year are no longer being accepted at this time.

Students are selected by lottery if applications exceed the number of positions available. There are no examinations required to gain enrollment, however, students are assessed after enrollment as a diagnostic tool to benefit teachers and prepare them to help new students access the curriculum.

All applications must be sent Certified Mail, return receipt requested, through the United States Post Office, or delivered in person to the school during our regular business hours.

Please Note: The address provided on this application will be used for all enrollment correspondence. The correct address is vital to meet enrollment process deadlines and assign a proper waitlist position. It is the responsibility of the family to notify the school of any changes in contact information.
