Class Descriptions

American Girl Doll Week Jessica Carroll

Bring your American Girl or another favorite doll to a fun-filled week. We will explore the world of the American Girl Doll. There will be many activities and craft projects related to the American Girl Doll. At the end of the week we will celebrate with a tea party. (students entering grades 1 - 3)

Backyard Games 1 Jessica Carroll

Four Square, Dodge Ball, Croquet, Horse Shoes, Badminton, Bocce Ball... If you can play it in the backyard, we will play it here! This class brings your favorite games together, and introduces you to new games that will involve both cooperation and competition. (students entering grades 1 - 3)

Backyard Games 2 Cheryl Lassey

Four Square, Dodge Ball, Croquet, Horse Shoes, Badminton, Bocce Ball... If you can play it in the backyard, we will play it here! This class brings your favorite games together, and introduces you to new games that will involve both cooperation and competition. (students entering grades 3 - 6)

Beetles, Bugs & Backyard Adventures Linda Noiseux

Put on your boots and head into the woods. Students will investigate the world of bugs. We'll look under rocks and see what we can find! Students will hunt for bugs, complete bug activities and make a bug habitat. (students entering grades 1 – 3)

Beginning Boxing Skills Karen Prizio

Learning how to box has long been a way of teaching youth fundamental life skills they will use the rest of their lives. The boxing enrichment program is designed to be a fun, safe and rewarding learning experience that offers boys and girls entering 4th, 5th & 6th grade the opportunity to become stronger mentally, physically and emotionally. Equipment will be provided. *Please bring a water bottle and a fitted mouth guard for the first class.* Instructor has been training for 3 years. (students entering grades 4 – 6)

Board Games Galore Cheryl Lassey

Design and create your own board game to take home!! You will design a board game relating to your favorite activity or subject or create your own version of one of your favorite games. We will use the computer to design your board and create game pieces too! Think about the rules, you will print them and then we will turn our hard work into "game time". (students entering grades 4 - 6) **Additional materials fee of \$5.00**

Candle Making **Cheryl Lassey**
Students will learn the craft of candle making. Students will create a different candle creation daily using a variety of techniques and materials.
(students entering grades 3 - 6) **Additional materials fee of \$5.00**

Fitness Fun in the Sun **Danielle Enos**
Come and enjoy the nice summer weather as we keep our minds and bodies fit. The children will learn movements that activate the brain as well as summer fitness games. The week will conclude with the children participating in a mini summer Olympics course and medals will be awarded. (students entering grades 1 – 3)

Floor Hockey **Ryan Pinsoneault**
Students will stay cool indoors while enjoying this great classic game. We will work on ball handling, passing, and team game-play throughout the session. Each day will end with a full game to showcase the newly learned skills. *Please wear athletic shoes and bring a water bottle.* (students entering grades 4 – 6)

Fun with Digital Cameras **Ryan Pinsoneault**
Students will become familiarized with digital camera use and a variety of digital media. They will learn how to make colorful and fun presentations such as slideshows, pamphlets, and newsletters which they will be sure to enjoy sharing with family and friends. *Students are strongly recommended to bring their own digital camera, and extra batteries.* (students entering grades 4 – 6)

Fun with Math **Rachna Koul**
Students will learn math concepts using games and fun activities. They will learn the fundamentals of math without realizing it! The course will include tricks, fun facts and hands-on games to help reinforce key math skills. (students entering grades 3 & 4)

Fun with Spanish 1 **Valerie Rodrigues**
Students will have fun with Spanish through songs, games, art and crafts.
(students entering grades 1 - 2)

Fun with Spanish 2 **Valerie Rodriguez**
Students will have fun with Spanish through songs, games, arts and crafts.
(students entering grades 3 - 5)

FUNdamentals of Cheerleading **Kelley Roy**
Students will learn basic skills involved in cheerleading. Activities will include age-appropriate conditioning (running), arm drills, jumps, cheers and stunting skills. Jewelry Making with Beads.....Cheryl Lassey
Let's make some beaded bling! Students will learn how to make beaded bracelets and necklaces with clasps. Once you learn the basics of jewelry design, you will have the skills to make so many more things. Come learn a new hobby that is way too fun!

Jump Start into Kindergarten:.....Cynthia DeTore/Rosemary Coelho
This course is designed for children entering kindergarten as of September, 2009. Children will be given an opportunity to become more familiar with the kindergarten classroom and participate in activities, which will follow a typical kindergarten routine. Get ready for some science fun! Students will explore the wild world of science. A variety of science experiments will be conducted each day. How does slime, volcanoes and rockets sound to you? Come join the fun, (students entering grades 1 - 3)

Motor Skills Development..... Ryan Pinsoneault
Students will work to develop their fine and gross motor skills by engaging in fun, supervised game-play activities. They will be painting, using play dough, threading beads, climbing, hopping, and all other great summertime activities!
(students entering grades 1 – 3)

Paper Mache Mania.....Carmen Alkins
Roll up your sleeves and get ready for some messy fun! We will create animals, masks piñata’s and more with paper mache’. *Please bring a protective smock.*
