Congratulations on your participation in the Advanced Placement program! Registration and fees for exams are due earlier than in previous years due to recent changes from the College Board. **The deadline to complete this form and submit the required fees for AP Exams is Monday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. Students MUST also “Join” their AP Section and select “YES” for taking the exam.** More information is available at <https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/register-for-ap-exams>.

- **The fee is \$95 for EACH AP exam.** There are two options for payments:
  - 1) Make checks payable to “FRCS”. Use one check for all exams (1 exam \$95, 2 exams \$190, 3 exams \$285, etc.). Students eligible for fee reductions should contact me. More information about eligibility for fee reductions is at: <https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/ap-coordinators/exam-ordering-fees/exam-fees/reductions>. Please note fee reductions have changed due to federal/state funding.
  - 2) Use your MySchoolBucks account through the Parent Portal on the school website.
- This completed form and payment are due to the high school by the end of the day Monday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. **This is a firm deadline.** There is a FRCS late registration fee of \$40 per exam.
- You may mail your form (and payment) to the school address or drop them off in an envelope at the Main Office. You must include: **ATTN AP COORDINATOR.**

All students taking an AP exam will prepare throughout the year. Teachers will be reviewing both test content and test strategy in class. Practice exam questions are available through the College Board at <https://apstudent.collegeboard.org/takingtheexam/preparing-for-exams>.

AP exams will be given between May 3<sup>rd</sup> and May 14<sup>th</sup>. The schedule is set by the College Board. The most up to date information about AP Exams is available at <https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/about-ap-20-21/ap-2020-2021>. AP exams allow students to earn college credits (with a qualifying score). Students usually take an AP exam after completing an AP course; however, any student can take an AP exam. Students approved for College Board testing accommodations will receive them for the AP exam. If you have an IEP or a 504 plan and have not received approval from the College Board for testing accommodations, please notify me if you would like to submit an application to the College Board.
